We are pleased to announce that this year FICPI Canada will hold its renowned Claim Drafting Clinic remotely. The clinic is a valuable experience for patent agent trainees who intend to write the qualifying examinations. Registration is open to all, including non-FICPI members. Attendees should have some exposure to patent drafting, which may be from private practice or a corporate or other practical environment (e.g. an educational clinic).

The program will take place over two Saturdays and is timed conveniently for our trainees across the country (June 12th and June 19th, 2021 at 9am-1pm PT / 12pm-4pm ET/1pm-5pm AT).

The program will include lectures, practical advice and workshops dedicated to drafting patent claims. The workshops will comprise new drafting exercises, so repeat attendees are welcome.

This Clinic is conducted as a service to our member firms and will be run at or near cost with experienced tutors. The registration fee is set at **\$150**. A hard copy of the materials will be mailed to attendees in advance. The registration fee is refundable until May 20, 2021. The registration portal will remain open until June 2, 2021 to ensure that we have sufficient time to provide the materials to attendees.
